AGREEMENT TO HOLD HARMLESS, DEFEND, AND INDEMNIFY
THE KERNVILLE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

In consideration of the Kernville Chamber of Commerce and/or its officers, directors, employees, sponsors, and agents (collectively known as "Chamber") allowing

(Name of Person, organization, or business entity, collectively known as "Permittee")

to participate in the 20__ **WHISKEY FLAT PARADE** ("Event"), which is sponsored by the Chamber, Permittee voluntarily enters into this agreement.

Specifically, Permittee agrees to and hereby releases and waives any and all claims for damages against the Chamber that Permittee, (and/or Permittee's officers, directors, employees, members, or agents and/or property, as applicable) may suffer in connection with my/our participation in the Event. These could be claims arising out of negligence, recklessness, incorrect decisions, strict liability, breach of contract, or any act, in any way, associated with my/our participation. Permittee will hold the Chamber harmless without limitation or reservation whatsoever, from any such liability, cost, expense, loss or damage. My/our participation in this Event is purely voluntary and I/we elect to do so at my/our own risk. I/we expressly assume all responsibility and risk (both known and unanticipated) to myself/ourselves, others and to property.

Permittee further agrees to hold harmless, defend (with legal counsel reasonably acceptable to the Chamber), and indemnify the Chamber without limitation or reservation, against any loss, damage, liability, cost or expense (including attorneys' and experts' fees and costs) resulting or arising from, or related to, any injury, loss, damage, claim or expense suffered (or allegedly suffered) by Permittee or by any third party and arising from Permittee's participation in the Event, whether by any negligent or intentional action or failure to act by Permittee, and/or its officers, directors, employees, members, or agents. Permittee agrees that should any suit or action, (in connection with my/our participation in the Event) be brought or threatened against Permittee, and/or against the Chamber as defendants, Permittee will, upon request by the Chamber, tender defense (with legal counsel reasonably acceptable to the Chamber) of such suit to such person or entity, who may elect to undertake defense of such suit. Any such defense will be at Permittee's expense, including attorneys' and experts' fees and costs. If any portion of this agreement is judged invalid, the validity of the remaining portion(s) will not be affected.

PARADE TIMES & GUIDELINES!

It's FREE! . . . There's no entry fee, as long as you send your registration so we receive it by February 2nd. (\$25 for any entry after February 2nd until February 11th, **NO PARADE DAY ENTERIES WILL BE ALLOWED**) But . . . the Kernville Chamber may gun-down entries for improper behavior or for not following these simple guidelines. Please aim for tasteful decorations, (for wholesome family spectators), in keeping with our parade theme.

Be pleasant . . . and timely . . . and help us present an outstanding parade.

What's my "Line-Up" number? Just ask us the morning of the parade at our check-in table on Sierra Way. Please don't call . . . and don't visit the Chamber office. . . . They won't know these answers.

Okay, but where do we check-in? We'll be at the usual line-up area – on Sierra Way, corner of Kernville Road and Sierra Way. Please don't arrive before 8:00 am or you'll be there ahead of us!

Helpful horse, mule, & donkey notes: Before you ride onto your line-up number, we'll show you where to circle up, together, for a little early-judging of costumes and tack (9:30 a.m. sharp). To avoid the "after-parade" skittish backtrack amid the crowded bridge traffic, drop off those trailers at the designated parking by the rodeo grounds and Whiskey Flat Encampment (near the parade's end).

Any Shootin'-Irons, Fellers? Everyone with a firearm (even unloaded) needs a visible, "**approved**" ribbon. They're issued starting Friday at the Whiskey Flat Encampment just across the street from the rodeo grounds.

Avoid long gaps in the parade march -- once it begins, there's **NO STOPPING, ANYTIME.**

No items, (candy, etc.) may be thrown to spectators (insurance requirements).

Make sure that your float or entry is **less than 15 feet tall** (to avoid overhead lines).

08:30 a.m.....Check-in & line-up (check-in table will open at 8:30 a.m.)
Please do not come to chamber office and do not come early.

10:00 a.m.....Start of the Whiskey Flat Days™ Parade.
Start waving those hands and flashing that smile, pardner!
